Samaritan Skit

A person walks out from the backstage, stumbles, and appears to fall on the person's head. S/he struggles noisily to get up, but can't seem to get his/her forehead off the floor.

S/he sometimes succeeds in getting into a position with his feet and his forehead on the floor, and his bum in the air. S/he rotates in this position, keeping the forehead in one place.

S/he calls for help, repeating loudly & slowly, "My forehead is stuck!"

As s/he struggles, other people walk casually past. (These people should be doing a variety of interesting things very different from the other people who walk by. They ignore him, or look with curiosity, but no one helps.

Finally a person comes running up and heaves the victim to his feet. The victim is extremely grateful, but the rescuer just stares at the victim's forehead while the victim thanks him/her.

Ignoring the victim, the rescuer reaches out, plucks something off the victim's forehead, and pops it into his mouth. (Say this very clearly, loudly & slowly while looking at the audience!) "Thanks!" he says. "I knew I'd lost my gum somewhere around here!"
