

Raisin, a skit for staff

2 or 3 people can each come out as a group in place of each of the people and help play the part with the person on the script.

1st person comes out and gets down on all fours pretending to be a table.

2nd person comes out, looks at the table and declares "Ahh, a fly, I'm a collector of wings! I need these wings for my collection! (This person dramatically picks up the fly, plucks off the wings, puts it back on the table, and walks off.)

3rd person comes out, looks at the fly on the table and says; "Oh! Legs! I'm a collector of legs, and these would be wonderful for my collection of legs!" With great precision and animation, this person picks up the fly, dramatically removes its legs, puts it back on the table and walks off.

4th person comes out, looks at the fly and announces; "Oh . . . an insect head! I collect insect heads! I desperately need this head for my collection!" Then the person proceeds as the other people before him/her.

The last person comes out, looks at the table, then carefully inspects the object without picking it up and says very loudly & slowly while looking at the audience, "**A raisin!**" This person quickly picks it up and eats it.
